Mon Feb 28<sup>th</sup>

We meet at 9.30 at the entrance of the Excavations of the old city of Herculaneum, the ancient Roman town which was buried by the eruption of Mt Vesuvius in 79AD.

We go back to school for lunch. Students bring their lunch packets.

2 pm: Workshops at school. Students will be divided into mixednationality groups and join the following workshops:

1.English Drama (coordinated by Eddie Roberts)

2. Creative art and jewellery (Ciro Mazza)

3.Eastern Dance (Imma Acampora)

4. The Tilgher Choir – Singing (Carlo Intoccia)

Tue March 1<sup>st</sup>

We meet at 8,30 am (Bar Fiorillo). two buses will take us to Sorrento; the little town has had a reputation as a tourists resort for ages. It has always attracted artists and standard tourists for the wealth of its ancient villas and monuments, the pleasant climate and the scent of its lemon and orange blossoms.

In Sorrento we meet our partner school, Liceo Scientifico "Salvemini": teachers and students will guide us around the city. (pupils bring their lunch packet or look for a light meal in local coffee shops) Italian teachers: Cardillo, Serpe

Expected arrival time in Ercolano: about 7 pm

Wed March 2<sup>nd</sup>

8.30: Bus leaves for Napoli. We will meet Representatives of the Regione Campania who are responsible for the new project "GEOvani Promossi senza confini".

After the meeting, Teachers and students will spend the day touring the city centre of Napoli. The tour will include some of the decumani of the ancient Graeco-Roman city, churches from the Middle Ages, Renaissance up to 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century, Castel Nuovo (or Maschio Angioino), Piazza Plebiscito and the Royal Palace and Castel dell'Ovo. (Italian teachers: Mazza, Raiola). After lunch, we have a bus tour of Posillipo.Expected arrival time at Ercolano: 5 pm Pupils have their own evening program.

## Thu March 3<sup>rd</sup>

We leave at 7.30 from Bar Fiorillo in Ercolano. The bus will drive us to Pozzuoli, where we take the ferry boat to the island of Procida. We will be hosted by the local Istituto Tecnico, High School; we are going to spend some time at school, later on a group of students and a teacher will guide us around the island. We take the ferry back to Pozzuoli at 5.25, and by bus we will go back to Ercolano. Expected arrival time: 7 - 7,30 pm

Fri March 4<sup>th</sup>

We meet at 9 am to visit the top of Mount Vesuvius.

Mt. Vesuvius is one the best known volcanoes on earth; it dominates the Bay of Naples with its characteristic cone. It is a typical example of a volcano in a volcano made by an outer broken cone, Mt. Somma (1133 metres) with a crateric belt most of which is destroyed. In it there is a smaller cone, the Mt. Vesuvius (1281 metres), divided by a valley named Valle del Gigante (Giants Valley), a part of the ancient caldron where in a later period, perhaps during the 79 A.D. eruption, the Gran Cono (Great Cone) or Mt. Vesuvius arose. Lunch at school (Italian students have their packed lunch for their partners). Afternoon: Departure of Belgian and German delegations Jordanian delegation and their Italian hosts will be at school working on project activities. Dinner with hosting families
